WHEREAS the above named Minor and Birth Parent/Legal Guardian each approve the following:

1. Authorization: Upon execution of this Submission Approval Agreement the Minor will be legally authorized to make written submissions of their original Work to Anthology Works for publishing consideration in one or more of their upcoming Anthology publications.
2. Submission Approval Agreement Limitation: This executed document does NOT legally authorize Anthology Works to publish any submission of original Work made by the above-named Minor without a written Publishing Agreement duly executed by all three representative parties prior to publication.
3. Indemnification: The above-named Minor hereby represents that he/she is the original and true author and owner of all their submitted Work. The above-named Minor and Birth Parent/Legal Guardian will not assign publication rights for any of the above-named Minor's submitted original written Work to any other party without first notifying Anthology Works. The above-named Birth Parent/Legal Guardian hereby agrees to defend, hold-harmless and indemnify Anthology Works against any claims of infringement or libel which may be brought against Anthology Works regarding the above-named Minor's written Work.
4. Duration: This Agreement shall be effective immediately upon written execution by all representative parties and shall remain in effect until the Minor's eighteenth birthday or a written notice of cancellation is received by Anthology Works at their above listed business address, whichever comes first.
5. Submission Approval Agreement dispute, controversy, or claim: Any dispute, controversy, or claim between Anthology Works and the above-named Birth Parent/Legal Guardian regarding this Agreement will be submitted to mandatory and binding arbitration under the terms of the rules of the American Arbitration Association as then in effect. All claims must be brought in the party's individual capacity and not as a class member in any purported class or representative proceeding. Arbitration proceedings shall be heard in Jackson County, Oregon, by a single arbitrator serving at the mutual designation of the parties and each party shall be solely responsible for their own attorney's fees in connection with said arbitration. Any issue concerning the applicability, interpretation, or enforceability of these procedures, including any contention that all or parts of these procedures are invalid or unenforceable, will be governed by the Federal Arbitration Act. No discovery will be permitted in connection with the arbitration and all aspects of the arbitration will be confidential. Any arbitration award shall not include exemplary or punitive damages. The arbitration award will be final and binding on the parties and may be entered in any court having jurisdiction.

6. The above-named Birth Parent/Legal Guardian shall have three (3) days from the execution of this Submission Agreement to cancel it for any reason by providing written notice to Anthology Works of their desire to cancel.
